Objectives of the call

Capitalisation of completed modular projects, based on

- TRANSFERRING of developed tools/methodologies
- MAINSTREAMING of results into policies

Starting point: concrete finalised deliverable/output



Project type

TRANSFERRING project

Process designed by "Giver" organisations, transferring a tool/methodology to "Receivers", with the aim to improve practices in the target area

MAINSTREAMING project

Process designed by "Givers" to transpose achieved project results into public policies, generating policy change with a formal commitment by the target institutions



Deliverables to be Capitalised

"Link with EU Green Deal": Important!

- Provide *perspective* to the new "capitalisation" effort
- Reaching with the next programming period and the new EU growth strategy



Expected outputs

2.1d	Number of regions and sub-regions engaged (through charters, protocols, MoU) in developing energy efficiency plans/strategies	
2.2e	Number of regions and sub-regions engaged (through charters, protocols, MoU) in increasing share of local RES in energy mix	
2.2b	Population of islands covered by plans	
2.2c	Population of rural areas covered by plans	

- Effective transposition/uptake by new territories
- Commitment of public authorities through binding agreements



Partnership requirements (I)

- Minimum 3 countries Recommended 6 partners
- ❖ GIVER Partner
 - Active Partner of the shortlisted project
 - Carries out the transfer/mainstreaming process
 - At least 2 givers

❖ RECEIVER Partner

- New Partners/territories
- Beneficiary adopts the identified outputs/results
- At least 3 receivers



Partnership requirements (II)

- Lead Partner must have been Partner in a completed project + contributed to the development of the selected output
- An organisation can be partner in only one proposal per Specific Objective
- Associated Partners also have Giver/Receiver roles
- Horizontal Project partners cannot apply



Financial allocation

- ❖ Indicative total call allocation: € 4 million
 - ERDF € 3 million + IPA € 400.000

❖ Indicative total project budget: € 400.000-500.000



What's new?

- Simplified Application Form
 - only one "technical" Work Package
 - simplified intervention logic
- Reduced reporting
 - > Two 8-month reporting periods, with midterm review

Pre-contracting and contracting procedures	March 2021
Starting date of the projects	March 1 st , 2021
